CODE OF CONDUCT

To become a member of Sale Nomads an annual membership fee is payable at the AGM in October or at the time of joining the club. Membership entitles you to enjoy social events and activities held at the club and you are also welcome to attend any nights the bar is open.

All we ask from you as a member is to follow this Code of Conduct and respect your fellow members, visitors to the club, and the staff of venues we may perform at. Etiquette and respect build the foundation of any good club or society. We appreciate that this is a hobby and a way to forget work or other day-to-day life. It is also a charity and for some, a sanctuary to be around like-minded people. Producing large productions can be at a great expense to the club (often at a loss) and a certain level of quality is expected from the paying audience.

As a Member of Sale Nomads Theatre Club you agree to follow this guidance at all times whether at the clubhouse or representing Nomads at an external venue;

- Arrive ready for rehearsals or meetings to start on time
- If you are going to be late for a rehearsal or you cannot attend, notify the relevant person as soon as possible
- Be aware of your behaviour in the rehearsal room and be respectful of others who are working
- Leave a room or venue clean and tidy ready for the next occupants
- Look after all items such as technical equipment, costumes, and props. Notify the relevant person if you notice any damage so repairs can be arranged
- Respect the authority of others in the scenario you are in, for example the production team if you are in a rehearsal
- Do not use inappropriate language for the environment you are in
- Do not attend if you are under the influence of alcohol and it is affecting your judgement and/or behaviour
- Nomads does not allow the use of illegal drugs on its premises or during its productions at any venue

If you feel anyone is breaking this Code of Conduct, please notify a member of the Nomads Council or the Production Team. (chairnomads@gmail.com)

Nomads does not wish any members to feel unsafe or uncomfortable at any time.

Anyone found to be breaking the Code of Conduct will be approached privately. If necessary, the Nomads Council can cancel membership of the club and ask an individual to leave.
